



In an effort to make your visit a pleasant one, the Board of Directors asks that a few traditions of Onondaga be observed:

GOLF ATTIRE:

Blue jeans, denim, spandex, sweatpants, tank tops, tee shirts, athletic shorts and cargo shorts are not permitted. For men, golf shirts with collars and sleeves, mock turtle and turtle necks are permitted. For women, shirts with collars or sleeves are permitted. For both men and women, only shorts of Bermuda length (almost down to the knees) are acceptable and shirts must be tucked in.

All hats must be removed inside the clubhouse.

CELL PHONES:

Cell phones and other electronic communications devices may not be used on Club property except inside automobiles and inside telephone booths in the main clubhouse.

SMART TECHNOLOGY & PERSONAL COMMUNICATION DEVICES:

Texting, e-mailing and other non-verbal functions such as calendars, contacts or other information is permitted in the Bar area, Mohawk Room, Seneca Room, locker rooms and Pool area.

CLUB CHARGES:

All club charges will be posted to your host's account. No cash transactions are permitted.

TIPPING:

Tipping of any individual employee is prohibited.

GOLF CARTS:

Children and junior golfers are not permitted to drive carts.

BUSINESS PAPERS:

Briefcases, business papers and laptop computers are not allowed in any room of the clubhouse.
