



## TRADITIONS & RULES

We are looking forward to having you as a guest at the Onondaga Golf and Country Club. To help make your visit more enjoyable, we have prepared this information for you regarding our Club traditions and standards. All Members, their families, and guests of all ages are asked to respect these traditions and standards.

**Bag Drop** – Upon arrival at the Club, please proceed to the podium in the Pro Shop area and use the bag drop. Our golf shop staff will direct you to the appropriate locker room.

**Locker Room Facilities** – As our guest, you will be provided a locker for your use. Please refrain from changing your shoes in the parking lot.

**Appearance, Dress Code and Conduct** – The purpose of the dress code is to ensure that sensible, reasonable standards are maintained on the Club premises and is reflective of the traditions of the Club. In general, all clothing should be clean, pressed and appropriate. For men, appropriate attire is traditional golf shirts with collars and sleeves and slacks or golf shorts of Bermuda-length. Shirt tails must be tucked inside shorts or slacks at all times. For women, appropriate attire is traditional golf shirts with collars or sleeves. Sleeveless shirts with a collar, crew neck or high neck are permitted and slacks and Bermuda-length (*i.e.*, exceeding fingertip length) golf dresses, skirts, skorts and shorts are acceptable. Shirt tails must be tucked in at all times, unless designed to be worn outside. Tank tops, tube tops, halters, strapless tops, tee shirts, sports mesh tops, cut-offs, sweat pants, yoga pants, denim, cargo shorts or pants (*i.e.*, with exterior pockets) and athletic shorts are not permitted. Hats and visors are to be worn with the brim facing forward and shoes with non-penetrating spikes should be worn at all times.

**Denim** – Appropriate denim, that which is worn with appropriate cut, is in excellent repair and is consistent in color, is permitted in the Bar (including the patio), Mohawk Room and Seneca Room. Inappropriate denim is denim worn or cut lower than waist level, baring midriff, tattered, frayed, patched or otherwise in disrepair or less than excellent condition.

**Cell Phones and Personal Communication Devices** – The verbal use of cellular phones and the retrieval of voicemail messages are prohibited on Club property except in the case of medical emergency or in designated areas of the Club (inside automobiles and telephone booths in the Clubhouse only). Texting, e-mailing and the use of other non-verbal and non-audible functions on personal communication devices such as accessing calendars, contacts or other information is permitted on Club property. All devices must be in silent or vibrate mode, must be used in a discreet fashion and in consideration of those around you. The camera function may be used in an appropriate manner throughout the facility except it is strictly prohibited in any of the Club's locker rooms.

**Golf Carts** – Please keep golf carts on paths where available (especially near tees and greens) and please obey all golf cart signs and barriers. Cart operators must be 17 years of age or older and have a valid driver's license.

**Club Charges** – All Club charges will be posted to your host's account. No cash transactions are permitted.

**Tipping** – The Club respectfully asks that you do not tip individual employees of the Club.

**Business Papers** – Briefcases and business papers are not allowed in any rooms of the Clubhouse, unless permitted in advance by Club Management.
